Your food and water will weigh approximately 15 pounds with your Team equipment weighing another 5 pounds. Your trip will definitely be more enjoyable if you keep your load light. Please limit your personal belongings on the bus to fit in a bag that is no more than 10"X10"X20". The required items on the list must be brought with you to the Eagle Claw Orientation session.
